*Just a couple of quick notes: Excellent show everybody, this is a good turnout for beginners ☺ I just want to mention a couple of things: when showing performance, please really keep an eye on the gait that the model is supposed to be doing. Most real life horses would not be asked to do a piaffe before jumping a jump in the show ring. ☺*

*Also, its usually not a good idea to name models the same name that Breyer uses for them, because if everyone did that, it would get really confusing.*

*Lastly, I have seen some super breed/color assignments. Always keep an eye out for reference links if you are showing something uncommon: especially where Warmbloods are concerned. Even though they are generally a “mix” of breeds (like Dutch WBs can have a TB dam and still be registered Dutch WB) there are still some body types and color unseen in the lines. Always do your research and prepare with a reference—it will help you \*tons\* in the show ring.*

*As far as taking your photos, just please watch those horizon lines and the yellowish light bulbs. You are allowed to adjust for lighting when editing/cropping your photos: but NO photo manipulation, changing out backgrounds or adding stuff into your photos: that’s considered cheating. (You’d be surprised how many real life photographers are model horse people—wink wink!)*
